cSPACE KING EDWARD

cSPACE King Edward is an arts hub located in Mohkinstsis (Calgary). We provide affordable studio, presentation, gallery, and working space for creative entrepreneurs and artists of all disciplines. We support opportunities for collaboration and change through fostering inclusivity and intersectionality in our vibrant creative community.

CREATIVE INCUBATOR INITIATIVE

The *Creative Incubator Initiative* is conceived in response to the challenges faced by creatives working in the arts sector as a result of the pandemic. This Initiative seeks to enable artists with access to creation space, technological support and cohort learnings in marketing, branding and communications. Participants will document and live stream their creative output, and explore new ways to distribute their creative practice on digital platforms. We welcome applications from artists working in all artistic disciplines who are seeking to re-emerge and explore new applications, markets or opportunities for their creative practice. The selected Filmmakers will be storytellers of that journey.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Filmmaker will:

- Connect and Collaborate: Work one-on-one with 4 artists in the Studio Theatre at cSPACE King Edward (hereafter referred to as the "Cohort")
- Create: Have weekly sessions over a period of 3-5 weeks where they will film the Cohort as they work to create their artistic project
- Capture: Document the progress and final product of the Residency

- Culminate: Provide brief vignettes of the work in progress for marketing and social media purposes. Produce a final 2-3 minute documentary of the entire artistic process, and provide raw content to the artist at completion.
- Compensation: Each filmmaker will receive \$2500 (inclusive of prep, filming, editing, and any required meetings). Approximately 20-25 hours per artist.

TIMELINE

- March 1st: Submission Deadline
- March 5th Successful applicants will be notified
- March 25th-30th: Filmmakers will provide the Cohort with a brief sample of their work
- April 1-10: One-on-one consultation with the Artists
- April 19th May 8th (approximately): Film in the theatre with the Cohort (4 hours each per week)
- May 9- 16th: Post-production and Editing work to support artist's intent for film
- May19th: Final delivery date of finished video

QUALIFICATIONS

- A minimum of three to five-years experience in the field is required
- Selected filmmakers should have experience making documentary films
- An understanding of various artistic disciplines and working with creatives is an asset

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applications Must Include

- Contact information for one main contact, including name, phone number, mailing address and email
- CV (maximum 2 pages)
- A one-page letter of interest detailing why you would like to be a part of this initiative
- 3-5 support materials showcasing your work (links to work hosted on YouTube, Vimeo, Dropbox, and Google Drive accepted)
- Reference to any relevant social media or web-based work

Deadline for application: Monday, March 1st

- Completed application packages must be submitted in PDF form. Email submissions preferred. Additional support (images) must be submitted in jpeg or png format.

Selected artists will be required to sign a Service Contract/Memorandum of Understanding with cSPACE. cSPACE has the right to not recommend any of the applicants if they determine that the submissions are not an appropriate fit for the facility. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
